Then he took the responsibility of Chunati Hakimia Alia Madrasha as the Chief Executive and he continued it until he passed away. He was a multi-dimensional talented as Mufassir, Mufti, Poet, literary personality, Translator and so on. He had good relationship with the political personalities. Also he was a member of Asiatic Society & jury board. He had good relations with Shere Bangla A.K. Fazlul Hoque. He participated in the anti British movement.
